Proof of Public Liability Insurance

The renter must submit proof of public liability insurance to the Société du Monument-Lefebvre no later than 30 days before the event.

Video and Audio Recording Policy

The use of private or external video or audio recording equipment must be validated by the Société du Monument-Lefebvre and the Parks Canada Agency no later than 30 days before to the event. In the current policy, the term "recording equipment" includes all devices capable of recording video, audio, images or sounds, and includes cellular telephones, cameras, and laptop computers.
